



Membership Structure

The E-Homebuying Forum exists to provide a platform for companies who wish to modernise the home buying process. The Forum works with Government and other industry stakeholders to provide industry-wide strategic vision and direction in pursuit of greater transparency, efficiency and commitment in the home buying process - with the goal of bringing faster certainty to the consumer.

The E-Homebuying Forum has a two tier membership structure:

Affiliate Membership - £500.00 per annum

Affiliate members receive the following benefits:

- Receipt of a key points summary from quarterly Ministerial meetings, meetings with the Land Registry and meetings with key stakeholders

Executive Membership - £4,000.00 per annum

Executive Members receive the above and the following benefits:

- Option to attend (on rotation with other Executive members) quarterly ministerial meetings
- Option to attend (on rotation with other Executive members) meetings with the Department for Communities and Local Government and the Land Registry
- Option to attend (on rotation with other Executive members) meetings with key stakeholders e.g. RICS, Which?, CML
- Option to attend (on rotation with other Executive members) meetings with key political stakeholders e.g. MPs, special advisers
- Executive Members wishing to spread the cost of membership over the course of a year should speak to the secretariat regarding a) quarterly or b) monthly membership payments
